

## What you can do

### ■ Make a regular donation

Fill in the **Gift Aid** form overleaf, if you are a UK tax payer and if you pay income tax and/or capital gains tax of an amount equal to or greater than the tax to be reclaimed by charities to which you have made payments under gift aid in any tax year. Gift aid declarations can only be made by individual tax payers, but cheques may be drawn on joint bank accounts (but not company bank accounts).

**£20 per month paid under gift aid is worth £300 in a full year to the Charity when we have reclaimed tax at 25%!** So for every four children supported by our Friends, HM Revenue & Customs will effectively support an extra child.



## Cost-effective giving!

£240 a year, or £20 a month, pays for full-time boarding education for a girl who would otherwise be condemned to leprosy, begging, child labour, prostitution, or whatever other form of poverty it was born into. Or, £40 covers the cost of rescuing a child from living on the railway and reuniting him or her with family or finding other safe accommodation.

Every single penny you donate will go to cover the direct cost of our work for children. None of your money will be spent on fundraising, salaries, administration, printing, advertising, travel or the other expenses associated with the more familiar charity appeals.

## Help a destitute child in India to live a better life



## Who are we? What do we do?

We set up our charity in 1992 to support a school for destitute children in Orissa (now officially known as Odisha), India's poorest state. We fund a boarding school for some 300 girls who have been abandoned by their families, or are from prostitutes' and leprosy colonies, and other disadvantaged groups. We also support several teams of social workers who rescue runaway and abandoned children from the railways in Odisha and help them to return home or otherwise to find safety. We do this by fund-raising events, circulars to regular and potential supporters and in other ways.

Committee members and other supporters visit Odisha regularly on other work, and other expenses are covered by in-kind donations. We produce a newsletter for our supporters about four times a year. These newsletters, and other information can be found on our website at:

## Our partners in India

■ **Palli Unnayan Seva Samiti (PUSS)** is a small voluntary organisation which has for over 30 years helped children in Odisha, one of the poorest states of India. In 1992 Kadambini Bhuyan, the remarkable woman who started **PUSS**, identified 20 little girls from a prostitutes' colony in Odisha, whose mothers were anxious to save them from the same life that they had to lead.

**PUSS** set up a small boarding section for these girls, and Professors Gerry Johnson and Malcolm Harper of Cranfield School of Management, who were teaching in Bhubaneswar at that time, started **Friends of the Children of Orissa** to support them. Since then the number of girls has risen to about three hundred. Kadambini died in 2008 and **PUSS** has since then been ably managed by her successor.



■ **Society for Children (SOCH)** was started in 2012 to help runaway and lost children who end up on railway stations in Odisha to be reunited with their families or otherwise to find a secure home. It's founder, Manoj Kumar, had earlier worked for a Bangalore-based institution which does the same work elsewhere in India, and he started **SOCH**, with our support, in order to extend the same assistance to children in his home state of Odisha.
